

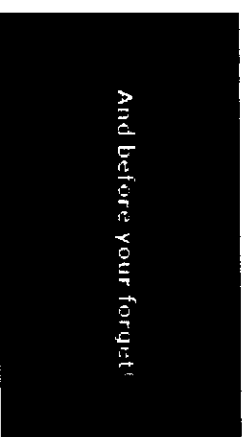

When I listen to Paul sing, it's almost frightening. I hear Caetano Veloso's great songwriting skills of consciousness from the late 1960's and early 1970's. He has Jorge Ben warmth, and depth musically with just a pinch of Bob Marley's yearning thrown in for good measure. I even feel some Don McLean seeping through his pores. By no means is Paul a mimic this guy is sheer talent in the making, definitely capable of standing on his own merits. Songs like "Rainbow" "Solomon" "Lefty Lucea" demonstrate Paul's natural strengths; which are his powerful delivery and intimate approaches to a song.
